



“WILD” Wysox River Challenge

Saturday, July 23rd

OVER \$2000 WORTH OF CASH AND PRIZES

The race will take place at the Wysox river front park under Rt.187 Bridge. Registration starts at 8am the race will start at 10am; **sign up day of the race**. The Pro will start facing upstream (13.7miles) while the touring (one lap 7 miles) and the recreational fun race (recreational 2 laps around downriver buoy and island approx. 3miles) will start downstream. Two major prizes will be up for grabs and

every paddler has a **chance to win** Epic (full carbon) Mid Wing Paddle and Cobra Explorer sit on top kayak) there will be other prizes as well...

Pro race (for those who train and race with regularity this will be close to a two Hours of racing) will start going upstream proceed to left side of island and this is where it gets interesting, there will be buoys with flags attached in the current for any seeking this monetary prize will have to go and get it (sure to add a little excitement). There will be at least **one hundred dollar flag and at least five more with money attached** for the paddler or paddlers fast and brave enough to get it. Then proceed to buoy, turning counter clockwise head downstream back pass start finish line counter clockwise around downstream buoy. Then head back upstream through current section then head to upper turn buoy again and back to finish ending on downstream at start finish line.

Touring Class (For those who train regular and race and don't want to race for 2hrs.) will start downstream turning counter clockwise around buoy heading back past start finish line **left of island** through current section turning counter clockwise around upper buoy and then heading down stream to finish one lap about seven miles.

Recreational Fun Race anyone can do this race with recreation kayak or canoe even if you get out once or twice a year . Paddlers will start facing downstream round lower buoy counter clockwise and head back past start finish line and round upper buoy before island (approx. 3 miles)...
